SOCIAL EVENTS

The under 9's had a busy month, playing 5 games, winning 3 and losing 2. They beat Beighton Magpies 9-1, Darfield 6-0 and Worksop Boys 9-3. Their 2 defeats came against Sheffield Rangers 1-2 and Greenhill Low edges 0-4.

However, there has been one major disappointment as Whitehill U12's were dismissed from the cup and also denied entry to next seasons competition after being found guilty of bringing the game into disrepute after their semi-final game was abandoned due to spectators fighting. Brinsworth Whitehill did appeal on behalf of the kids and were successful in being allowed entry into next season's competition but the ban this season remained. This is a very disappointing for the team after they had worked so hard to reach that stage of the cup only to be denied by completely avoidable circumstances. BWJFC hope that this severe punishment and the distress it has caused the children will serve as a severe warning to all parents that unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated as at the end of the day it is the kids who suffer.
