SOCIAL EVENTS

RESULTS/PERFORMANCES

Brinsworth Juniors U8's had their best ever win so far as they beat Throstles 10-2 with goals from Richard Caley 3, Sam Jackson 4, Tom Grayson, Oliver Morris and Joe Turner. They also had a 2-2 draw against Brunsmeor Alex Clark and David Mason scoring. U8 Whitehill had 3 close fought games, losing 4-2 against Brampton Rovers, and Dodworth, and 5-4 against Chesterfield Town, (Aaron Edge, Luke Cutts, Jordan Thomas-Ramsden and BJ Scaife). The U9's had a 10-3 victory over Hillsbro Pumas in the cup, Josh Carpenter 3, Callum Marcus 4, Joel Murray, Lewis Dalmedo and Cameron Ball all on the scoresheet. The U10's beat Middlewood 7-2, (Cardwell 2, Rathbone, Watts, Potts, Kaye, Scott) and drew 2-2 with Thorncliffe, (Walker Potts) in the league. They also reached the quarter finals of the cup as they beat Dodworth 6-0, (Walker 3, Potts, Cardwell). Whitehill U13's have also reached the quarter finals of the league cup as well as progressing to the latter stages of the Sheff & Hallamshire Tesco Cup. They also remain undefeated in the league and are strong contenders for the A division title. As we approach the halfway stage of the season, Whitehill U12's and 14's are both in a strong position and are challenging for promotion. The U11's sit comfortably in mid table, but can be pleased to their start to life in the top division. The Seniors have reached the semi-final of the Rotherham Charity Cup and quarter final of the S&H Sunday Senior Cup.
