However, what was different about the launches was that for the first time they hosted an exclusive preview evening beforehand. The rooms were brought to life with experts from worlds of gastronomy, wine tasting, sound and vision, and beauty. Strata's design team, who created the kitchens and interiors for the showhomes, were also available for customers to meet and talk to.

RESULTS/PERFORMANCES

U7's Whitehill can also be pleased in their opening campaign winning 9 and losing just one. In November they won all 3 games against, Birley Spa, 20-0, (Harry Day 7, Ciaran Jeavons 3, Liam Addenbrooke 4, Robbie Pritchard, Bobby Joe Scaife, Sam Green 3, Jordan Thomas), Bramley Sunnyside 15-1, (Green 3, Jordan Thomas 3, Day 5, Addenbrooke, Jeavons, Scott Bowley & Myers) and Sheff Utd Junior Blades 8-4, (Day 3, Addenbrooke 2, Green 2 and Scaife). The U8 Juniors managed a 7-7 with Redfearns, (Joe Skidmore 3, Stephan Payne 2, Lewis Szanto 2). The U9's were another team to win all their games in November which included a cup win against Aston Rangers 6 -1, (Joshua Cardwell, Joshua Walker, Adam Rathbone, Brandon Potts and Jacob Watts) and league wins against Whiston Wildcats 15-0, (Brandon Potts 4, Cardwell 2, Rathbone, Walker, William Scott 2, Billy Hewitt 2 and Thomas Smith 2) and Abbey Lane 12-1, (Smith 2, Walker, Scott 2, Potts 3, Ben Gosney, Jacob Watts 2 and Lewis Kay). Other teams to progress in the cup were the U10's, 7 -1 v Thorncliffe, Bradley Bartholomew 4, Cameron Parkin 2, Cory Wainwright) and the U12's 4 -1 v Hoyland Common Falcons, (Charlie Hinchcliffe 2, Mitchell Hughes, Billy Warham). This season we are running 4 girls teams, U9's, 10's, 11's and 13's. The games are played on a Saturday at the Outokumpu or Brinsworth Manor School. The U11's, (Y6), have vacancies for players.
