### **CLUB CONSTITUTION**

Although the committee fully expect the section to be cleared of this allegation we feel we must remind players, managers parents and spectators that when representing BWJFC we expect them to behave in a manner which does not bring the club into disrepute. This includes not abusing opponents, referees, opposition spectators or even your own children, be it racial, verbal or otherwise. Anyone found guilty of such behaviour may find themselves being de-registered from the club. ### **ADVANCED COACHING**

Congratulations to Director of Coaching, Steve Smith who has achieved his UEFA B coaching badge. A solitary goal from Adam Green saw the U-11's through against Outibridge whilst the U-13's also won by the odd goal, beating Todwick Juniors 2 - 1 thanks to Rollinson and Schofield. The U-10 girls had a comfortable 4 - 0 score against Aston, (Holly Mappin 3 Chloe Allen) and will meet Greasbro in the semi at Greasbro on 28<sup>th</sup> January.
