Whitehill U10's have reached the semi-finals of the League Cup with a 2-0 victory over Redfearns, (William Scott, Chris Mitchell). In the league they beat Bramley Sunnyside 6-2, (Hewitt, Potts, Cardwell, Walker, Kaye, Scott) and drew 1-1 with Dodworth, (Scott).
