SOCIAL EVENTS

PITCHES-OUTOKUMPU/AURORA

Due to the amount of spectators stood on the sidelines and on numerous occasions, encroaching onto the pitch, a decision has been made to rope off all pitches on the Outokumpu. This will also enable the groundsmen to preserve the area along the touchlines. When the pitches are roped off everyone, apart from the club officials and substitutes, **MUST REMAIN BEHIND THE ROPES** at all times. Referee's and team managers will be asked to enforce this ruling. Each section will be asked to erect the ropes on the day so help from parents would be much appreciated.

We would also like to remind you that dogs are not allowed on the Outokumpu in any circumstances.

There is a large congregation of youth's gathering on the Aurora and in general are disturbing training sessions by encroaching onto the pitches. Many of these are players with other sections from BWJFC. There are also problems with others playing football in Brinsworth WMC car park and generally causing a nuisance as well as putting themselves in danger. Could you remind your children that the Aurora is not open to the general public and therefore they should only be in the vicinity during their own training sessions and that it is dangerous to play in the club car park.

Training will continue at the Aurora until the end of April, with all sections being instructed not to train on any pitches at the Outokumpu or Brinsworth playing fields until further notice.

RESULTS/PERFORMANCES

Congratulations to the U9 girls who have reached the final of the League Cup, where they will play Crosspool at the Outokumpu on 21st April.
