MESSAGE FROM THE SECRETARY

Thank you to everyone who supports the club over all its activities.

I try and visit games and training sessions as often as possible and it is always a pleasure to talk to parents etc. One main issue that many people talk about is "Where does our money go?"

Well as you all know the club charges only **£3.00 subs** when you have a game and £1 when you do not.

Let's take as an example the 11 aside game and a section that has 16 registered players. This section has to pay in £38 per game or £16 when there is no game. Costs of referees and Pitch Hire average approx £30. Match fees out of the £38 are £22 therefore the club subsidises a home game by at least £8. When you play away then the club gains the £22. Therefore approx £8 per week is gained per section for the club.

The other £16 is the membership fee, which entitles everyone to take part in the Draw for £30 and 2, £10 weekly and a £100 monthly. We have approx 350 players and therefore take in approx £350 per week on the draw. Pay out is £50 plus save £25 per week towards the £100 monthly draw. This leaves approx £275 per week which goes towards paying for the training facilities at Aurora. We have to hire 24 pitches per week which costs considerably more than the £275 and with each section requiring kits, balls nets etc we have to look at other ways of raising funds as well as subscriptions that we try to keep at a minimum. We therefore are reliant upon the social functions and the gala to raise monies for the terrific presentation nights and trophies etc that the club hands out to everyone.

Certainly as secretary of this great club I do not wish to see subscriptions increase and we have to emphasis therefore that we would welcome as much support as possible at all our social functions.

I hope this précis helps you understand the financing of the club and answers the frequently asked question "Where does our money go?"
