### **FACILITIES**

### **MAJOR SPONSORSHIP DEAL**

Brinsworth Whitehill Junior Football Club has signed a three year sponsorship deal with Strata Homes, Yorkshire's leading home builder, worth a five figure sum per annum over 3 years.
