RESULTS/PERFORMANCES

Brinsworth Juniors U7's had a goal from Joe Cooke in their game v Hoyland Town. Joe also scored against Killamarsh with Callum Jarvis scoring 2. Tom Grayson, Willam O'Byrne and Richard Caley 2, scored for the U8 juniors in a 5-4 defeat at Bramley Sunnyside, whilst Sam Jackson scored against Handsworth. Whitehill U7's scored 4 against Dodworth, Callum Jackson, Ronan Hodgkinson, Elliott Carpenter and Ben Mitcheson with the goals with Ronan also netting at Dronfield Town. Whitehill U8's beat Crosspool 7-1 with goals from Jack Dourke, BJ Scaife 2, Steve Jeavons, Robbie Pritchard and Liam Addenbrooke 2. Despite goals from Robbie Pritchard and Kieran Jeavons they lost 6-2 at Redfearns. The U9's lost 2-1 at home to Thornccliffe, (Taylor Askham), Drew 3-3 at Brunsmeer, (Lewis Dalmedo, Lewis Szanto, Callum Marcus) and beat Wickersley 5-2 in the cup, (Sam Woodcock, Adam Raynes, Taylor Askham, Lewis Szanto and Callum Marcus).

The U10's also went through to the next round of the cup as they won 6-1 at Chesterfield Town, (Scott 2, Walker, Cardwell, Mitchell and Watts). In the league they drew 2-2 at Rawmarsh St Joseph's, (Brandon Potts 2), but lost 3-1 to Redfearns, (Callum Doyle).
