PORTAKABIN

The portakabin situated at the Outokumpo cost the club £1500. RESULTS

For the girls, the U-10's have won all three games, including a 10-1 scoreline against Doncaster Parklands and 12-0 against Aston, a game in which Charlie Hussain scoring an incredible 9 goals.
